I. MISSION STATEMENT

The Plymouth Owners Club Golden State Region, dedicated to the preservation and historical value of Plymouth and other motor vehicles, has established a scholarship to be awarded to two recipients each academic year whose actions have demonstrated an excellence for achievement and commitment to better themselves and their community through higher education. The personal educational development of the students and the value of their return to others embodies the essence of our goals.

II AMOUNT AND PAYMENT

The amount of the scholarships for each academic year shall be a minimum of \$250.00 each. Any increase of the scholarship shall be determined and approved by the membership at the annual meeting. The scholarship monies may be used for tuition fees, books and supplies. Supplies may include tools necessary for class. A check shall be made payable directly to the school to establish a credit in the name of the student. The scholarship will be available for one year after the award announcement and if in the event the student is not enrolled in an accredited institution within that year or terminates his course of study any undisbursed scholarship monies will revert to the scholarship fund for future use.

III ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be a graduating high school senior in the state of California maintaining a 2.0 GPA or higher, enrolled in automotive instruction for 1 or more years and be accepted for admission in a higher course of study at an accredited community college, university, trade or technical school in the United States for the fall term following graduation.

IV AWARD CRITERIA

Recipients may be chosen based on any of the following criteria, which may not be limited to or all inclusive.

- Community volunteer service
- Leadership awards, honors or academic achievement
- Involvement in extra curricular activities
- Financial need
- Credits earned through automotive instruction

V SELECTION

A panel of three members will review applicants. This panel is comprised of , 1.)The current POCGSR president, 2.) A POCGSR Scholarship committee representative and

3.) A volunteer POCGSR member whose residence is in the closest possible proximity to the applicant.

#### VI SUBMISSION

The application and supporting materials must be received by April 1<sup>st</sup>. Applicants may be contacted for a personal or phone interview during the selection process. Recipients of a scholarship will be notified by June 15<sup>th</sup>.
